Bitches in season may compete in the last brace of the last stake on each course that day. AKC approved tracking collars are allowed.

Overnight camping is permitted. No open fires allowed on the grounds. Camping is confined to the designated parking area. Water will be available for animals. Please bring your own drinking water. **Please close all gates.**

American On-Site Services will be doing a mid-week for RV's requiring service. Cost \$50.00 per RV

Per BLM only certified weed free hay allowed On BLM Grounds. We will have certified hay available for purchase on site.

BLM will inspect the grounds following the field trials. Absolutely no dumping of horse manure over the field barbed wire fence or the wood cliff fence. All horse manure will be hauled off to a different location. A designated trailer/truck will be available. All horse and dog manure needs to be transported to the designated vehicle. The Brittany clubs continued use of these grounds depends on our total compliance in this issue.

Absolutely no smoking on site or outside of your vehicles.

Only permitted vehicles allowed to drive on any course.

Please clean up your area before you leave. Clean up all manure and, spread remaining hay, fill in all holes, and remove all debris. **Future access to these grounds are dependent on the state in which the grounds are left.**

Please take a moment to thank all our judges and other volunteers – our trial would not be possible without them.

## Directions to the trial grounds

**From East:** Take I-90 Exit #231 toward Tokio Weigh Station onto Danekas Rd/N. Durry Rd. Turn right on N. Hills Rd. which becomes Harrington/Tokio Rd. Continue six miles. Cross bridge over Crab Creek and turn left, go thru the gate into camping area of Goose Butte Mgmt. Unit. Please re-close the gate

**From West:** Take I-90 Exit #226 and turn left on E. Schoessler Rd. over I-90 to T intersection. Turn right on Danekas Rd. to Harrington/Tokio Rd. then turn left N. on Hills Rd. which becomes Harrington/Tokio Rd. Continue six miles. Cross bridge over Crab Creek, then turn left, go thru the gate into camping area of Goose Butte Mgmt. Unit. Please re-close the gate

# AKC Code of Sportsmanship

*PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
